### Social Outreach Activity Report

The department of Computer Science of Bharata Mata College conducted a survey among the common people. The purpose of the survey was to know how the common people were aware about the E-District Portal, the online service by the government and to organize a training programme which aims to make people literate about how easily access the services provided by the E-District portal.

The survey was conducted by means of google forms. The survey included the following questions:

- Are you aware of the E-District portal of Kerala Government?
- · Have you ever used the E-District portal?
- · What is the most convenient way to access the E-District portal
- As per your opinion, what makes it difficult to access e-District portal?
- Select the services that you have received using the e-District Portal.
- Have you ever encountered any problems while using the e-District portal?
- Select the services that you have received using the E-District Portal.
- Do you want to learn how to use the e-District portal?

The Google form received 180 responses. Most respondents between the ages of 15 and 30 used the E-district portal; most of these respondents were students. In contrast, respondents between the ages of 31 and 60 either rarely or never used it; the data collected indicates that these respondents are either unemployed, retired, self-employed, working in the private sector, or employed by the government. Additionally, those between the ages of 15 and 30 do not have a strong preference for using the e-district portal on a personal level. However, those between the ages of 31 and 60 prefer using the e-district portal on a personal level, and those over 60 prefer Akshaya centers.


### Padheyam

### Mentoring Report

The Computer Science department follows the mentoring system initiated by mentoring Cell. The students are grouped and assigned a mentor teacher who is responsible for collecting academic performance and class attendance of individual students.
