NOTICE

Based on the resolutions passed in the Examination Committee meeting held on 26.08.25 and the college council meeting held on 11-09-2025, the following decisions are hereby notified.

- Course-wise attendance will determine the eligibility of FYUGP students to appear for End
 Semester Examinations in each course.
- The minimum attendance requirement is 75% for boys and 73% for girls for each course. UG students failing to meet this requirement must apply for condonation and pay a fee of ₹315 + ₹50 per course to become eligible to write the exam.
- UG Students whose attendance percentage is less than 65% for a particular course (below 65% for boys and below 63% for girls) will not be permitted to appear for the End Semester Examination of that course. They are required to pay a fine of ₹315 + ₹50 per course towards notional registration.
- For PG and Integrated PG students, average attendance will be considered. Students who don't
 have minimum attendance (75% for boys and 73% for girls) must apply for condonation and pay
 Rs. 700 to become eligible to write exam.
